


ABOUT BALLINASLOE

Ballinasloe is a town located in County Galway, in the west of Ireland. It is situated on the River Suck and is the second-largest town in the county, with a population of around 7,000 people and over 15,000 in its hinterland

Ballinasloe has a bustling commercial centre, with a variety of shops, restaurants, and other businesses. The town has a weekly country market, where locals and visitors can buy fresh produce, crafts, and other goods.

• Ballinasloe is a charming town with a rich history and many attractions nearby for visitors to enjoy, including the 18th-century St. Michael's Church, which features beautiful stained glass windows, and the 16th-century Garbally House, which is now a private school but can be viewed from the grounds. Historical sites of The Battle of Aughrim, The Famine Memorial Park and Clontuskert & Kilconnell Abbey are all close by. The new Ahascragh Distillery is situated on the outskirts of the Town.





Outdoor enthusiasts will also find plenty to do in the area, with opportunities for fishing, boating, and other water activities on the River Suck and a 20 berth Marina in the Town Centre. Ballinasloe is also located on The Beara-Breifne Way (Ireland's longest national waymarked trail) and has numerous walking and running trails and loops including a 6 lane running track.

TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTATION

Ballinasloe is easily accessible with 2 access points off the M6 Dublin-Galway Motorway and is excellently serviced by public transport.

Multiple bus services including Bus Eireann and City link operating to Galway City, Athlone, Limerick and Dublin. Local Link Services also link the area with the towns of Castlerea and Portumna.

There is also a train station served by the Dublin-Galway railway line.

There are numerous taxi companies services the area and for those who prefer to travel by bike, there are several cycling routes in the area, with the Galway to Dublin Greenway route when completed to pass through Ballinasloe.



THINGS TO DO

- St. Michael's Church: Visit St. Michael's Church, an 18th-century church that features beautiful stained glass windows and a peaceful atmosphere.
- Famine Remembrance Park: Visit the memorial park situated in Cleaghmore
- Garbally House: Explore the grounds of Garbally House, a 16th-century residence that is now a private school, and admire the stunning architecture.
- Go Fishing: The nearby River Suck offers great fishing opportunities for trout, pike, and other species.
- Ballinasloe Library: Visit the Ballinasloe Library, which
 offers a variety of books, movies, and other media for
 borrowing, as well numerous events and activities.









THINGS TO DO

- Outdoor Adventures: Explore the great outdoors by hiking on the many local routes or bog trails, cycling, or kayaking on the River Suck.
- Ahascragh Distillery: Tour the newest Irish distillery transformed from a nineteenth century mill into an eco-distillery and visitor centre.
- Historical Sites: Visit the numerous nearby historical sites, including the Battle of Aughrim, Clontuskert Abbey, Clonfert Cathedral & Kilconnell Abbey
- Ballinasloe Golf Club: Play a round of golf on a challenging 18 hole parklands course with beautiful views of the surrounding countryside.
- Ballinasloe Country Market: Visit the Ballinasloe Country Market,
 held every Friday
- Cinema: Visit the newly constructed 5 screen Omniplex cinema
 complex located in Dunlo Shopping Centre.











SHOPPING













The main shopping areas in Ballinasloe:

- <u>Town Centre:</u> This is the main shopping area in Ballinasloe, and is home to a variety of independent retailers and chain stores including fashion boutiques, gift shops, and artisan food shops. You will also find a range of shops and services, including cafes, hairdressers, and beauty salons.
- <u>Dunlo Shopping Centre:</u> Located walking distance of the town centre, with Large Supermarkets, Coffee House and 5 Screen Cinema.
- Ballinasloe County Market: Ballinasloe hosts a
 weekly County market on Friday Mornings, where
 you'll find a range of local produce, crafts, and
 goods. The market is held in Emerald Ballroom, and
 is a great place to pick up some treats and gifts.


